Matthew 5:17 Do not suppose that I have any intention of doing away with the Torah or the Prophets. My purpose is rather to place them on a firmer footing by interpreting them correctly in terms of God’s ultimate will as He originally intended for His commandments to be obeyed.

The Law of God, also known as the Torah, emanates from the abiding goodness of God’s nature and thus stands forever, God being unchangeable. When we observe the Torah, it is a reflection of His Divine Nature resident within us.

Today's Torah Portion Exodus 25:1 — 27:19

1. KJV Exodus 25:2 Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering: of every man that giveth it willingly with his heart ye shall take my offering.
2. The biggest subject in Torah is the building of the tabernacle. In 25:9, 26:30, and 27:8, it states that the construction should follow the pattern shown in the mount. Why all the detail for us?
3. Exodus 25:8, "And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them.", can we understand the blueprint for assembling the tabernacle of Moses as an example (1 Cor. 10:11) for the ordering of our lives? If so, then how?
4. Exodus 25:15 "The poles are to remain in the rings of this ark; they are not to be removed."
5. What do we take away from this order based on the patterns found in the tabernacle as it relates to the plan of redemption?

Peer Review: Fulfilling Scripture

1 Thessalonians 5:21 Test everything! Grasp a hold of that which is determined to be true.

Proverb 18:17 The first to present his case seems right, until another comes forward and examines him.

Peer Review is a process that journals and white papers use to ensure the information that is published represents the best scholarship currently available.

What should happen is that when a journal or white paper is ready to be published, the editors should send it out to other scholars to get their opinion on the quality of the scholarship, its relevance to the field, its appropriateness for publication, an evaluation of its sources, etc. Unfortunately, for the Hebrew Roots world, this seldom happens.

We, at the House of David Fellowship, will attempt to help fill this void. We hope to finish our first assignment in February. We will publish the results on our Blog for public consumption and debate.
