What Yeshua said about his Purpose

Today's Torah Portion Exodus 38:21 — 40:38

1. What spiritual principle for our lives can be extracted from Ex 38:21 where Moses performed a "pass in review" of the actions associated with the building of the tabernacle?
2. Ex 40:34 talks about the filling of the tabernacle. Let's discuss what we should take away from this first filling knowing the future.
3. The beginning of Exodus discusses the children of Israel that descended into Egypt (and slavery). The end of Exodus discusses the descent of the glory of Yahweh covering the newly finished tabernacle. In between, a great nation came into existence, they learned about the problems golden calves can cause, (even if they are named Yahweh), and found out what it takes to live in His presence on an ongoing basis. As the journeys are about to begin, what message do we take away for our lives today?

Peer Review: Fulfilling Scripture

1 Thessalonians 5:21 Test everything! Grasp a hold of that which is determined to be true.

Proverb 18:17 The first to present his case seems right, until another comes forward and examines him.

Peer Review is a process that journals and white papers use to ensure the information that is published represents the best scholarship currently available.

What should happen is that when a journal or white paper is ready to be published, the editors should send it out to other scholars to get their opinion on the quality of the scholarship, its relevance to the field, its appropriateness for publication, an evaluation of its sources, etc. Unfortunately, for the Hebrew Roots world, this seldom happens.

We, at the House of David Fellowship, will attempt to help fill this void. We hope to finish our first assignment in February. We will publish the results on our Blog for public consumption and debate.
