What Yeshua said about his Purpose

Matthew 5:17 Do not suppose that I have any intention of doing away with the Torah or the Prophets. My purpose is rather to place them on a firmer footing by interpreting them correctly in terms of God's ultimate will as He originally intended for His commandments to be obeyed.

Today's Torah Portion Leviticus 21:1 — 24:23

1. Leviticus 23:27-32 Verse 27 mentions that the 10th day of the 7th month is a sacred assembly. It appears that verse 32 mentions that the 10th day begins at the evening of the 9th day and goes until the evening of the 10th day. Is that correct?
2. Leviticus 23:5 Both the Hebrew and the Greek text use the phrase "between the evenings". What does this mean in its relationship to the Pass-over?
3. Leviticus 23:6 How many days is unleavened bread to be eaten?
4. Leviticus 23:6 From this verse, can we determine what day is the first day we should eat unleavened bread? If not, then is there another that is clearer or assists in a better understanding?

Peer Review: Fulfilling Scripture

1 Thessalonians 5:21 Test everything! Grasp a hold of that which is determined to be true.

Proverb 18:17 The first to present his case seems right, until another comes forward and examines him.

Peer Review is a process that journals and white papers use to ensure the information that is published represents the best scholarship currently available.

What should happen is that when a journal or white paper is ready to be published, the editors should send it out to other scholars to get their opinion on the quality of the scholarship, its relevance to the field, its appropriateness for publication, an evaluation of its sources, etc. Unfortunately, for the Hebrew Roots world, this seldom happens.
